DIRECTIONS: Tell the student that he or she is going to read some made-up words and that you will time him or her. If the student does not read all the words in two minutes, stop the reading. After sounding out the letters, say the word while running your finger under it. Say: $/ b / / \bar{a} / / p / ; b a p e$. Now it is your turn to sound out and read the next word. See how many you can read in two minutes.
